Many 2010 prospects outside of the noticeable *Rivals.com* top ten are starting to make a name for themselves thanks to the spring and summer AAU/club circuit. One prospect in particular is Mesa Mountain View High School 6-foot-3 sophomore shooting guard **Jordan McLelland**. Now a sophomore, McLelland is preparing to enter his first season for the Toros.

Last year as a freshman, McLelland attended Stapley Junior High, near Mesa Mountain View HS, since freshmen are not permitted to attend Mesa Mountain View HS until their sophomore year of high school. While at Stapley, McLelland starred on the freshman basketball team, leading the team in scoring and assists, while also shooting from a very high percentage on the floor.

Since the end to his freshman season at Stapley, McLelland has been attending practices with the Mesa Mountain View HS team, and also played extremely well for the Toros this off-season in local spring and summer leagues. While the Toros will look to find another scorer this season to

compliment the attributes of star guard [Brendon Lavender](#) (verbally committed to the University of Arizona), McLelland proved this off-season that he just may be the guy.

"He finds a degree of satisfaction in trying new things and getting better," said Jordan's father **John McLelland**.

Jordan works hard daily on his game with personal trainers and even works out with highly publicized local trainer **Warren Anderson**, where he often trains side-by-side with such pro-athletes as **Donovan McNabb**.

This spring and summer, McLelland traveled on the AAU/club circuit with **Anthony Ray's** highly acclaimed **Arizona Magic Blue** squad, where he first saw very little playing time, but then earned valuable minutes with the team. McLelland actually started several games for the Magic Blue in several local tournaments where he helped the team win numerous games.

This high school season, McLelland will compete on Mesa Mountain View's varsity golf team as well. McLelland competed with the varsity team last season as a freshman, after shooting below par in several high school varsity matches. McLelland was permitted to compete with Mountain View's varsity golf team last season, as freshmen were permitted to compete in the sport of golf.

This season McLelland will look to make an impact on the Mesa Mountain View HS team through being a great teammate. He advised *Arizona Preps* that he plans to continue to "work hard, share the ball, play great defense, rebound, and shoot a high percentage when given the opportunity to score."

McLelland is already receiving considerable interest from BYU and Utah, and advised us that he also likes Arizona, Arizona State and Stanford.

McLelland is also a great student and carries a perfect **4.0 GPA**.
