Things are steadily progressing for **Luke Roh**, a 6-foot-3, 180-pound point guard from Scottsdale (Ariz.) Chaparral who's worked out for a few teams recently and said his coach is hearing from a few others.



Roh said a few new programs are showing interest.

Pepperdine and San Francisco have gotten involved with Roh, who had been hearing from Colgate as well. He said his coach has also been talking to Boise State and Weber State, signs that things are starting to pick up a little bit.

"It's just starting to get going," Roh said.

Getting out on the AAU circuit with his Arizona Rebels team has not hurt his recruitment this spring. He will be playing in the Double Pump Tournament in Los Angeles this weekend, has already played in the L.A. area once this spring and has been to Phoenix as well.

Whether teams are getting word about him from those tournaments or from elsewhere Roh said he is not sure. He's just happy that the interest is starting to pick up from various schools across the West Coast.

Roh said getting out more and playing AAU has helped his game and probably has aided in his recruitment as well.

"I like it a lot," he said. "We played in two showcases and I didn't do that at all last year. I kind of liked it and it's kind of good to get going before the school months start so you know what you're doing before you get back.

"I love it. It's every basketball player's dream to start getting those calls."
